

Select support. ① Bite piece ② Chin cup ③ Chin rest	1	3
Select program.	Basic program (Standard) Interproximal panoramic program (Advanced program, optional) Orthogonal panoramic program (Advanced program, optional) Panoramic program for Bitewing (Bitewing, optional)	Traditional beam path and angles. Used in the detection of caries. X-ray beam perpendicular to the jaw. Practical for examination of the gums. Produces images similar to Bitewing images.

Patient positioning		

Patient positioning

- Position the patient's head so that the Frankfort plane is aligned with the Frankfort plane light beam.
- Position the patient's head so that the midsagittal plane is aligned with the midsagittal plane light beam.
- Osition the patient so that the apices of the upper central incisors are within the unit's image layer (focal trough).







Exposure

Press the exposure button and hold down for the duration of the exposure.
