Maintenance and cleaning

After working day

Daily routine

- Olose the milling unit software by tapping on the **X** in the upper right corner of the screen.
- 2 Touch **OK** on the *verification* screen.
- 3 If the lid is open, close it.
- When the lid pops open, wipe down the inside of the milling chamber and the lid.
- Leave the lid open to allow the chamber to dry out overnight.
- Touch Windows symbol in the lower left corner.
- Touch Power symbol.
- Select Shut down.







Indicator icon explanations

- If the Cleaning Wizards icon turns red, either Cap cleaning, Cap and Collet cleaning, Tank cleaning or Annual maintenance is required.
- If the Tank cleaning icon turns red, clean the tank immediately.
 - •The milling fluid tank must be cleaned after 6 hours of milling time or after 7 days, whichever occurs first. High volume offices need to clean the milling fluid tank more frequently.
 - If you're using e.max blocks, clean the milling fluid tank more frequently.
 - If you're using Zirlux FC2, clean the tank both before and after use.


- If the Cap/Collet Cleaning indicator turns red, clean the collet and spindle cap immediately.
 - Cap must be cleaned after 9 hours and collet after 30 hours of milling time. Once the maintenance is done, the counters are set to zero and the maintenance notification disappears.

- Advanced maintenance is required once a year or after 120 milling jobs, whichever occurs first.
- If the Water Level indicator turns red, the water level is too low to continue milling. Add water immediately.






Scheduled maintenance

Cleaning fluid tank and filter

- 1 Touch the **Tank cleaning** icon.
- 2 In the Clean Milling Fluid Tank Wizard touch **Next**. The milling unit starts to prepare for cleaning.





- 6 Follow the step-by step instructions.
- When the Success! screen appears touch

Cleaning spindle cap and collet

- Touch the Cap/Collet cleaning icon.
- 2 In the Cap and Collet Cleaning Wizard select Clean Cap AND Collet.
- 3 Select **Guided Cleaning Wizard**. The milling unit starts to prepare for cleaning.

- When the You have successfully completed the collet cleaning wizard! screen appears, touch **Close**.









Milling unit maintenance for extended idle time

To prevent mould growth or build-up of porcelain and grinding fluid, do not leave the fluid tank in the milling unit for extended periods of idle time.
